



The Pine Tree was an early symbol of America's battle for independence. It appeared on a flag with the words "An Appeal to Heaven."

As in the days of the founding of this Republic, we are living in times when we, as a people need to make an appeal to heaven. But what does this mean?

This phrase is often heard in Christian circles and was

In Exodus 29:45 after our Israel ancestors, became a nation, God said, "And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their God. (46) And they shall know that I am the Lord their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I am the Lord their God." So, Locke as well as our Christian founding fathers knew that when tyranny arose, and when all of our pleas have been exhausted to

the government, our only hope and ultimate plea and petition has to be to our God. Therefore, Locke wrote: "And where the body of the people, or any single man, is deprived of their right, or is under the exercise of a power without right, and have no appeal on earth, then they have a liberty to appeal to heaven, whenever they judge the cause of sufficient moment. And therefore, though the people cannot be judge, so as to have, by the constitution of that society, any superior power, to determine and give effective

John Locke had a tremendous impact on the early colonists and was often cited by the founding fathers. In fact, Richard Henry Lee, a signer of the Declaration of Independence, saw the Declaration as being inspired from the writings of Locke. Locke was not only one of the most-cited political philosophers during the Founding Era, but the single most frequently-cited source in the years from 1760–1776 (the period leading up to the Declaration of Independence).

Our founding fathers designed and created America to be a White, Christian nation. It was to be a special and separate nation - a nation like no other. Just like Biblical Israel, America was created and designed for a particular people, a holy people. Evidence shows that the white race is the offspring of those ancient Covenant people - the scattered tribes of Israel. Acts 10:36, "The word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by

Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all."), Romans 9:4, "Who are Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises."

Just like Israel, America was created and designed for White Christians. And just like Israel in Exodus 33:16 the Lord would be the God and King of Israel (America as well). "For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have

y sight? Is it not in that thou goest all we be separated, I and thy people, from all the people that are upon the face of the earth?" For example, on March 26, 1790, the first session of the U.S. Congress gave us our first immigration law which limited U.S. Citizenship as follows: "Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of American in Congress assembled, That, any alien, being a free white person, who shall have resided within limits and under the the jurisdiction of the United States for the term of two years, may be

admitted to become a citizen thereof, on application to any common law court of record."

John Jay, writing in the Federalist Paper #2 stated, "With equal pleasure I have as often taken notice that Providence has been pleased to give this one connected country to one united people- a people descended from the same ancestors, speaking the same language, professing the same religion, attached to the same principles of government, very similar in their manners and customs, and who, by their joint counselors, arms, and efforts fighting side by side throughout a long and bloody war, have nobly established general liberty and independence." Supreme Court Chief Justice John Marshall states, "No person, I believe, questions the importance of religion to the happiness of man. The American population is entirely Christian and with us Christianity and religion are identified."

In1840, United States v. Dow, the Supreme Court said, "<u>The colonists were all of the white race</u>, and <u>all professed the Christian religion</u>...If any person of a different color or professing a different religion had come onto the colony, he

would not, at that time, have been recognized as an equal by the colonists, or deemed of participating with them in the privileges of this community."

All the territories created in North America up until 1863 specified that citizens are to consist of "free white persons:" The Territory of Indiana -1808; The Territory of Orleans – 1811; The territory of Illinois -1812; The Territory of Missouri -1812; the Territory of Mississippi – 1814; The territory of Michigan -1819; The Territory of Alabama – 1819; the Territory of Florida – 1822; the Territory of Arkansas -1832; the Territory of Wisconsin -1836; the Territory of Iowa - 1838; the Territory of Oregon - 1848; the Territory of Minnesota -1849; the Territory of Oregon – 1848; the Territory of Minnesota -1849; the Territory of Utah -1850; the Territory of New Mexico -1850; the Territory of Washington -1853; the Territory of Nebraska -1854; The territory of Kansas -1858; the Territory of Colorado -1861; the Territory of Nevada -1861; the Territory of Dakota -1861; the Territory of Idaho -1863. However, our leaders have betrayed the children of the Republic, which are the White Christians and abandoned the laws of the Bible.

In the book of Jeremiah, the prophet laments about the destruction of his beloved city, Jerusalem, as Israel's leaders betrayed their people

and their God. Remember, we are the same people of Israel. Just like the days of Jeremiah, we as a people lament the

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destruction of our beloved America. A nation built by our people and for our people. Our people see the destruction of America and pray to God to deliver them from this filth. Jeremiah 2:21 says, "Yet I had planted thee a noble vine, wholly a right seed: how then art thou turned into the degenerate plant of a strange vine unto me? (23) How canst thou say, I am not polluted, I have not gone after Baalim? See thy way in the valley, now what thou hast done: thou art a swift dromedary traversing her ways;...(25) There is no hope; no; for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go...(27) for they have turned their back unto me, and not their

face: but in the time of their trouble they will say, Arise, and save us. (28) But where are thy gods that thou hast made thee? Let them arise, if they can save thee in the time of thy trouble: for according to the number of thy cities are thy gods, O Judah. (29) Wherefore will ye plead with me? Ye all have transgressed against me, saith the Lord."

Likewise, in America, the people plead to our government for deliverance because of the troubles we are seeing. That isn't working. And now we must make our Appeal to Heaven for deliverance because of the immorality we see around us. But what is our people pleading to God for? and what are they pleading to be delivered from? Yes, our people see the massive illegal aliens flooding into America (reportedly 5 million illegals just in the 2 ½ years of China Joe's presidency and this doesn't count the so called legal nonwhite immigration), the transgender movement, the body mutilation of our children, abortion, and devaluation of our money. But these are just the results of our sins. If we are going to make an appeal to heaven, our people need to recognize that they have betrayed God by accepting the two greatest sins: race mixing and homosexuality. See Luke 17:26-30. In the days of Noah, you had race mixing and in the days of Lot, there was rampant homosexuality. These were the two signs before the return of God. These are crimes against nature. Race and gender. America, the regathering place of Israel as foretold in Scripture, was founded and created for White Christians. Our forefathers acknowledged it

through our laws, our people acknowledged it through their actions and customs. America was a White nation and a Christian nation. However, we have betrayed the laws in the Bible by accepting miscegenation and homo-sexuality. As a result, America's holy vine that was

planted by God has been corrupted and polluted. If we are going to destroy the corruption within America and be under God's blessings again, then we need to acknowledge our sins of miscegenation and homosexuality and remove it from our land and start loving our God and loving our people. That must be the Appeal to Heaven we need to pray for. Just like 2 Chronicles 7:14 says, "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."
