Don't look at the person to your right or to your left. Don't look to the politician or even the preacher - look inside you!

Numbers do not count. The children of Israel had to walk into the Red sea before the waters departed. David had to go and face Goliath **alone**. The soldiers in Gideon's army had to be reduced to 300. God can save by many - but he can also save by few. We don't

need big numbers, it is nice to have them - but we don't **need** them. What we do need is faithfulness. My husband often points out that no where in the Bible does it say WE win. Often times people will say, I read the end of the book and it says WE win. But Tom reminds them it doesn't say we win - it says **God wins!** If WE want to win we have to be on the winning team and we can only be on the winning team if we are faithful.

And part of the faithfulness is the willingness to submit to the Lord and take a message of hope and repentance to our people.

Don't play God. Those you don't think God is interested in could actually be someone that God will use in a powerful way. Consider reprobate Saul became faithful Saint Paul. And someone who appears righteous before men might not make the team. Remember the story of the Pharisee who went to pray and in his prayer he boasted before God of his righteous life. Then there was the other man who went to pray and Christ said he beat on his chest and cried, *"God be merciful to me for I am a sinner."*

We don't always know in whose heart the light of White Christian Revival will strike.

In the early church, Christians met in homes - those homes - I suspect were mostly small homes with a small attendance. But the power of Christ coming out of those small gathering of Saints *changed the world*.

We are told in the first commandment not to put other gods before the Lord. But too often the God of fear dominates their life. Mostly it seems people shrink with the simple accusation that they are a racist.

As my husband often says, when you get to the pearly gates Saint Peter isn't going to have a check list to see if you had all of what some may say are the right doctrines of the church. The test of our lives is, Did you love your God and did you love your people? Or did you love fear over faith?

On a side note, people need to get out of the cities. Too often when people are wanting to leave the cities the first thing they think of is moving to an area where there is a higher demographic of white people, and that

is good. But don't just ***run from*** the invasion, but ***run to*** where there are others who are of like mind and spirit, others that can share your concern and offer encouragement and strength. If you have kids it is especially important to get out while you still have some control over them and they won't fight you. As they grow they will understand the purpose and wisdom of your decision. And I want to point out what Tom has said many times. The two most dangerous places to send your kids to is public school and church. Now obviously if it is a church which preaches the identity of our people and a love for race, faith and homeland, then they need to be in that church every

week. But most churches have no concern about preserving our white heritage. In fact they will encourage inter racial marriage, claiming skin color means nothing as long as both the man and woman are Christians.
